78 rooms including 33 suites






Foremost Royal Residence
For nearly two centuries, the Rambagh Palace has been home to generations of royals. Built in 1835 on a modest scale for the queen's favourite handmaiden Kesar Badaran, it was later refurbished as a royal guesthouse and hunting lodge.

In 1925, Rambagh was converted into a palace, and became the residence of Maharaja of Jaipur.




Built by Maharana Jagat Singhji II






Shambhu Prakash – Grand Presidential Suite




Built in 1894 by Nawab Vikar-ul- Omra, the Palace was later used as the residence of the Sixth Nizam Nawab Mehboob Ali Khan. Passed on for generations like a precious jewel, Falaknuma Palace or '*Mirror of the Sky*' was the royal residence of Nizam Mehboob Ali Khan.



Former residence of the Prime Minister of princely state of Jaipur since 1745, is spread across 18 acres of regal gardens.

The Natani-ka-Bagh at Jaipur was the garden house of an 18th century Rajput chieftain Hargovind Natani. The garden house became a monument to fame 124 years later, when Dr. Thomas Hendley came to live here, and became Jaipur's most prolific historian and art patron, of the 19th Century.



TAJ NADESAR PALACE, VARANASI


A haven for those seeking inner and outer peace.
